- (1) The Evening MBA Program annual rate is based on the 54 credits split evenly over the standard 8 semester program choice. Students may accelerate or decelerate the credit hours to align with their desired completion date.

New Program, showing Full Program Fee, as students are guaranteed the rate for the duration of the program and are billed in multiple installments.

- (2) This new program is replacing the Modular MBA Program and renaming the Weekend MBA Program. The program fee rate is guaranteed for the duration of the program and is billed over multiple installments.

- (3) The Masters in Comparative Law Program is offered by Emory Law in partnership with an international institution. Students spend the fall semester taking 8 credit hours at the partner institution and the spring and summer semesters taking 16 credit hours in residence at Emory Law. Upon successful completion of the program, the students receive the MCL degree from Emory Law.

- (4) Semester rate for Online JM program is \$2,500 per credit hour times 6 credit hours—3 credit hours each term; 2 terms per semester. JM Online tuition structure changed in FY21.

- (5) Medical students have the option to enroll for an additional year beyond the standard 4 year enrollment, but will not be assessed tuition for that year.

- (6) Allied Health Programs tuition rates are based upon market conditions. Students in these programs are non-traditional.

- (7) The InEmory MSN program is only applicable to those students who graduated from the InEmory BSN. The Annual Cost of the program supports 9 credits over the course of 12 months. Any additional credits taken will be assessed a per credit fee of \$833.33.

- (8) The total cost of the program is based on 48 credit hours over 3 semesters. (Per credit hour rate = \$1,608)

* Annual rates are based on the standard number of semesters for the program.
